
A tale of two Air Reserve Bases

Joint Base Cape Cod aka Otis Airbase. Air National Guard F-15 Fighter squadron moved to Westfield Mass after 911. Today this a major training area for Army National Guard soldiers in the Northeast, here soldiers practice maneuvering exercises and bivouacking, or camping, and use the small arms ranges. The northern 15,000 acres of the JBCC is the largest piece of undeveloped land on Cape Cod and is home to 37 statelisted species living in a variety of habitats throughout the base. The JBCC also sits atop an underground aquifer that supplies drinking water to Upper Cape Cod
